



# Vintage Synth Miniatures Pricing

## About the Builder

Ronaldo Lopes Teixeira Rolt, an Illustrator and graphic designer, although now retired, is a Prog Rock lover and vintage synth fan. He lives in São Paulo, Brazil, and has been producing artwork and models for many years as a hobby, although more recently he's been promoting his 'vintage synth miniatures' through attending synth related events in Brazil, so his models and skills have reached a wider audience, but this is still a hobby.

Ronaldo was invited by Mr. Michel Geiss (Jean-Michel Jarre's partner) to make an exhibition at Synthfest in France last June 2019, and was commissioned by UVI, the well known French Music Software Company, to produce 53 miniatures among keyboards and drum boxes from them.

## Q&A

### RL Music:

How long does each model take to make, so what would be the lead-time from order to shipping?

### Ronaldo:

It depends on the accuracy of the details and the work employed, I take 2 days for (ex. Mini Moog) to 15 days (ex. Steinway Grand Piano) to make them. All the synths front panels I redesign and print it out in high quality for better results. When I receive orders for multiple models then the lead-times will increase of course as it's just me that produces them. The best thing to do is request an ETA at the time of ordering with Richard at RL Music, as I will know what my current work-load is at that time and how long it will take to make the model(s) you are looking to buy.

### RL Music:

Can you produce custom models to order?

### Ronaldo:

I can make pretty much anything, although I prefer making the 60s to early 80s synths that we would consider 'vintage.' The PDF that Richard has provided shows 70+ instruments that I have previously built, either for myself or for customer orders, but that's not a fixed catalogue, so if you don't see your favourite in that PDF then please ask Richard for a quote to make a custom one for you and we'll add that to our catalogue.

**RL Music:**

What materials you use to produce your models with?

**Ronaldo:**

I use basically Balsa Wood and a lot of other materials such pins and telephone cords. Special papers, paint, bond glue, plastic sticks etc...everyone is in a 1/6 scale. In the PDF that Richard has supplied called 'Ronaldo\_the\_builder' you will see pictures of me and my workshop, building the models, so those images will I hope give you a good idea of my work space and materials etc.

**RL Music:**

What do you charge for shipping each model?

**Ronaldo:**

Using the postal service here in Sao Paulo/Brasil, to ship world-wide for a box measuring: 23 x 13 x 16 cm, costs around USD \$40. The models are all different in size, and multiple orders will mean a bigger box of course, so it's best to speak to Richard at RL Music for a custom quote depending on your requirements.

## A Guide to Pricing & Payment

Based on the instruments listed in the PDF called 'vintage\_synth\_miniatures\_gallery,' here are the prices for each model listed/pictured. As mentioned in the Q&A above, if you have a favourite synth that's not listed in the PDF the contact Richard at RL Music for a quote to produce the model(s) you would like to have made.

Payment for the Models will only be accepted via this PayPal account: **info@rlmusic.co.uk**  
If PayPal is absolutely not an option for you then speak to Richard.

Richard at RL Music will raise an invoice in USD\$ depending on your model(s) requirement, and that may include shipping in advance. Custom orders might require the shipping to be paid separately, once the models are packed and then quoted for shipping.

We have only listed the prices in US Dollars to simplify the process as much as possible because although RL Music trades internationally, with multiple currency types, to keep a constant track of the exchange rate changes for these items would be a full time job just updating this price list. Ronaldo, transacts in US Dollars, so we will provide payment to him in US Dollars (via PayPal also), and will request the payment from our customers to clear in US Dollars in our RL Music PayPal account where we accept US Dollar payments.
